NATIONAL TEAM HIGHLIGHTS:

2013 – First year playing with the Senior National team; competing in all 4 exhibition tournaments and 2 games leading up to FIBA Americas... Participated in all 6 FIBA America games, helping the team secure a spot at FIBA Worlds 2014, averaging 5.67 points, 2.83 rebounds and 1.17 assists per game.

2011 - Member of the 2011 Development Women's National Team where she participated in the 2011 Summer Universiade in Shenzhen, China where she averaged 13 points and 34 minutes per game in the five games the team played in the tournament.

2010 - Participated in exhibition games to play with Chile and Sweden where 16 minutes, 9.33 points and 1.7 rebounds per game averaged during the Exhibition Games.

2008 - Led Canada in total scoring for three-game exhibition series in China against Chinese Olympic Team... Game high scorer with 21 points in game two of the series, including 2-2 shooting from three-point range... Pulled down 8 rebounds in 25 minutes in game three

2007 - Saw action in all eight games of FIBA U21 World Championships for Women averaging 6.3 points... Helped Canada to best ever finish for age-group women's team with sixth place finish... Scored 16 points in win over Mali... Scored 10 points in loss to France... Saw action in all eight games of FIBA U19 World Championships for Women averaging 11.2 points and 9.0 rebounds per game... Led Canada in scoring average, second in rebounding average... Scored 14 points in win over Japan... Scored 10 points and 12 rebounds in loss to Australia... Scored 12 points and 13 rebounds in loss to Brazil... Scored 13 points and 10 rebounds in win over China... Scored 13 points and 15 rebounds in rematch win over Brazil

2006 - Logged a team leading 27.2 minutes over five games at the FIBA Americas Qualifier in Mexico City... Finished with a tournament best .923 free-throw average and placed tied for sixth with 12 free-throws made... Averaged 8.4 points and 3.2 rebounds for the tournament... Tallied 12 points and seven rebounds in a key victory over Puerto Rico, August 11... Participated in the Senior Women's National Team Training Camp prior to the Jack Donohue International Classic vs. Brazil... Started in all five games of the FIBA Americas leading the team with an average 26.2 minutes... Finished first in the tournament averaging 9.0 rebounds... Finished ninth in the tournament, second on the team with 9.0 points... Finished 10th in the tournament, first on the team with 1.8 steals... Scored a double-double in the semi-final vs.

Brazil with 19 points and 12 rebounds...June 23 vs. USA, finished with a double-double, 10 points and a game-high 10 rebounds... Recorded two assists

2005- Saw action in two games of the FIBA World Championship... Competed in a pre-2005 FIBA World Championship exhibition series held in France averaging 1.6 points and 2.0 rebounds per game... Played on the Junior Women's National Team in L'International de Basketball de Quebec averaging 2.8 points and 2.5 rebounds per game.

SENIOR (2009-10) Ranked second on the team in points (9.9), rebounds (6.1), assists (1.7), and blocks (1.3)... Led team in steals (1.3) and 3-point shooting (.382)... Named team MVP... Third Team All-Conference... Led team to 2nd round of NCAA tournament... Registered a new career high versus Miami University when she scored 29 points... Named Team Captain for second straight season.

JUNIOR (2008-09) Ranked third on the team with 10.1 points per game, second in rebounds (7.1), assists (2.5), blocks (0.8) and steals (1.1)... Started all but one game... Registered 5 double-doubles, scored in double figures 17 times and registered double digit rebounds 9 times... Scored a career high 27 points versus Central Michigan... Grabbed a career high 16 rebounds versus Navy... Finished 10th in the Atlantic Conference in rebounds... Named Team Captain.

SOPHOMORE (2007-08): Ranked third on the team in overall and three-point field goal percentage...Led all Flyer reserves in minutes played (19.3 mpg), assists (1.6 apg) and steals (0.7 spg)...Nominated for ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District honors... Corralled a season-high eight rebounds three times, all off the bench, in wins over Drexel and back-to-back victories against Cornell and Central Michigan... Scored 15 points and grabbed six rebounds against Charlotte in the second round of the A-10 tournament...Blocked one shot, made two assists, and grabbed three rebounds in 18 minutes of play against Bowling Green in the WNIT.

FRESHMAN (2006-07): UD's most consistent bench performer during her first collegiate season...she played in 30 of 31 games and started two while averaging 5.3 points per game and 4.0 rebounds per contest...Finished with six games of double figures in scoring and two in rebounding...Made her first collegiate appearance with two rebounds in 20 minutes played at Louisville in the season opener...Finished with eight points, four rebounds, two blocks, an assist and a steal the next day against Memphis...Came off the bench for an injured teammate to score 10 points on 4-of-9 shooting from the field and pull down nine rebounds in 27 minutes of action against Long Island...Followed with her first career start against Loyola-Chicago just four days later and collected a season-high 14 rebounds while scoring eight points...Put up a double-double with 11 points and 10 rebounds including seven boards in a win over Fordham...Scored a season-high 14 points against both St.
