



Warren Reynolds—Athlete Induction Class of 2001

- Born in Winnipeg, AB
- '57 & '58 National Junior champions (league stretched from Moncton to Victoria) Nortown Motors & YMHA Toronto. The '58 team played in the senior league in Toronto and won the championship
- Attended Etobicoke Collegiate Institute where his team regularly packed the gym on Friday nights
- Participated in 1959 Pan Am Games (Chicago)
- Recruited by Tillsonburg Livvies at the age of 20
- Livvies qualified for pre-Olympic then Olympic competition and had to raise \$35,000 to fund their trip
- 1960 Olympics – (back then the qualifying tournament was part of the Olympics) all players were presented with competitors medal
- qualified at 1964 pre-Olympic competition in Yokahama, where team finished with a record of 7 wins and 2 losses
- Competed in 1964 Olympics in Tokyo, Japan
- Averaged 11.4 points per game and was 100% from the free throw line
- After retiring from basketball, Reynolds competed heavily in squash, becoming national champion in 1982
