NATIONAL TEAM HIGHLIGHTS:

2018: Kenya played six games and finished second at the U18 FIBA Americas in Mexico City. She played 75 minutes and contributed 16 points, 9 rebounds and 2 steals.

2017: This was Kenya 's first time representing Canada at international competition. She played in all 5 games of the tournament, and logged a total of 87 minutes, playing on average 17.4 minutes per game. In total, she scored 19 points throughout the tournament, and had an average of 1.4 rebounds per game.

PROVINCIAL TEAM HIGHLIGHTS:

2018: Kenya was a member of the U17 Team Quebec who won silver at the National Championships in Fredericton. She averaged 15.5 minutes per game, 4.5 points per game and 3.25 rebounds per game.

2017: Won gold at the 2017 Canada Summer Games and averaged 15.2 minutes per game, 4.8 points per game and 3.2 rebounds per game.

2016: In her second time at the tournament, it was evident that Kenya was not new to the tournament. She played in all 5 games, averaging 22.9 minutes per game, along with an increased PPG and RPG average from the previous year, averaging 9 points per game, and 4.4 rebounds. These numbers got her being named to the 2nd All-Star Team from the tournament.

2015: Kenya's first time representing Team Quebec at the National Championships was a success. Playing in all 5 games, and averaging 18.4 minutes per game, on top of this she averaged a total of 5.2 points per game and 1.4 rebounds.
