NATIONAL TEAM HIGHLIGHTS:

2017: On her debut with the Senior Women's National Team she played in all 6 games averaging 20.6 minutes per game, and 4.8 points in China.

2015: Played in 6 exhibition games with the Development Women's National Team in China. Helped Canada finish with a silver medal at FISU games in Korea
