NATIONAL TEAM HIGHLIGHTS:

2018: In her second year with the Senior Women's National Team, Fogg contributed 3.0 points per game, 1.0 rebounds per game and 0.5 assists per game at the Edmonton Grads International Classic this summer. At the China Exhibition, Fogg played two games and averaged 1.5 points per game. At the Japan Exhibition, Fogg played one game and contributed 2 points.

2017: Made her debut with the Senior Women's National Team when she travelled with the team to China for a series of games in July. As member of the Development National Team, she travelled to Asia for the U24 Four Nations tournament in Tokyo, Japan and the 2017 FISU Universiade in Taipei, Taiwan. She averaged 19.6 minutes per game and 8 points per game while in Japan. While at FISU she averaged 18.4 minutes per game, 7.5 points per game and 7.16 rebounds per game. Canada finished 7th at this tournament.

2016: Member of the Development National Team and played five games in the Prague Open. Averaged 12.8 minutes per game and 5 rebounds.

2015: Helped Canada finish with a silver medal at FISU games in Korea
